entitled:

AMENDED, BY AMENDING SECTION 6 THEREOF TO CHANGE THE USE OF

The intent and purpose of the bill are expressed in its title.

FSM Finance, Chuuk Representation Office certified on May 6, 2005 that
\$912 remains from the \$10,000 previously appropriated for Chuuk
Northwest Region Transportation in Public Law No. 13-36, as amended.
The intent of this bill is to use the \$912 for Northwest Islands'
Transportation and Fuel (POL). Your committee agrees with the
amendment to Public Law No. 12-36 proposed by the subject bill.

and purpose of C.B. No. 14-38 and recommends its passage on First
Reading and that it be placed on the Calendar for Second and Final
Reading.
