

A BILL FOR AN ACT

To further amend Public Law No. 16-62, as amended by Public Law No. 16-71, by amending sections 2 [~~and 4~~] 4, 5 and 6 thereof, to [~~modify the use~~] change the use and allottee of certain funds previously appropriated therein to fund public projects and social programs in the State[s] of Pohnpei and Chuuk, and to offer a technical amendment thereto, and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA:

1           Section 1. Section 2 of Public Law No. 16-62 is hereby  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "Section 2. Of the sum of \$1,050,000 appropriated by  
4 this act, \$[~~255,000~~] 150,000 is apportioned for Kosrae  
5 State for public projects and social programs.

2            Section 4. Section 6 of Public Law No. 16-62, is hereby  
3 further amended to read as follows:

4            Section 6. Allotment and management of funds and  
5 lapse date. All funds appropriated by this act shall  
6 be allotted, managed, administered and accounted for  
7 in accordance with applicable law, including, but not  
8 limited to, the Financial Management Act of 1979.  
9 The allottee shall be responsible for ensuring that  
10 these funds, or so much thereof as may be necessary,  
11 are used solely for the purpose specified in this  
12 act, and that no obligations are incurred in excess  
13 of the sum appropriated. The allottee of funds  
14 appropriated under sections 2 and 4 of this act shall  
15 be the President of the Federated States of  
16 Micronesia or his designee, PROVIDED THAT the  
17 allottee of funds appropriated under subsection  
18 4(1)(c) of this act shall be the Pohnpei  
19 Transportation Authority. The allottee of funds  
20 appropriated under subsection 4(2)(c) of this act  
21 shall be the Secretary of the Department of Resources  
22 and Development or his designee. The allottee of  
23 funds appropriated under section 3 of this act shall  
24 be the Governor of Yap State. The allottee of funds  
25 appropriated under subsections 5(1)(2)(4)(5) and (6)

1           shall be the Chuuk State Commission on Improvement  
2           Project (CSCIP). The allottee of funds appropriated  
3           under subsection 5(3) of this act shall be the  
4           Executive Director of the Northern Namoneas Social  
5           and Economic Development Authority. The funds  
6           appropriated by this act shall remain available until  
7           fully expended.

8           Section ~~[3]~~5. This act shall become law upon approval by  
9 the President of the Federated States of Micronesia or upon its  
10 becoming law without such approval.
